BRACELETS

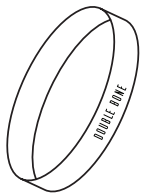
▶ PRINTING OPTION

To get the best results, you will need to check your printing settings and ensure that the 'page scaling' option is set to 'none' in the print dialogue box. The DB Wrist Sizer must be printed on a full letter (8 1/2 x 11 inches) size page. To check that the Wrist Sizer has been printed properly, take a ruler and measure the sample below. It should measure exactly 2 cm.



▶ HOW TO USE THE DOUBLE BONE WRIST SIZER

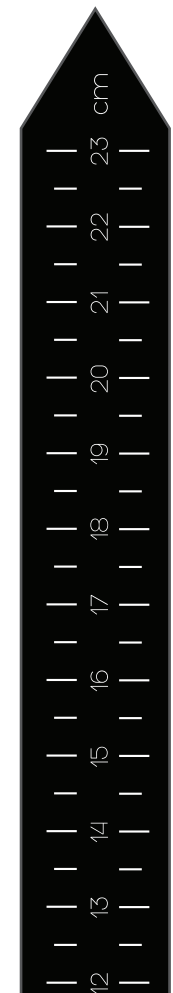
- Cut out the paper Wrist Sizer and follow the instructions below.
- After the Wrist Sizer is cut out, cut a slit on the sizer where it indicates [cut here].
- Make sure that the numbers are on the outside of the paper Wrist Sizer and insert the pointed end through the opening you have cut at the other end of the Wrist Sizer. Place your hand through the Wrist Sizer and pull the pointed end until it fits comfortably on your wrist.
- The number that lines up with the edges of the opening is the size of the wrist.
- You can also use a tape measure but if you do not have one, take any small piece of ribbon or cord. Wrap it around your wrist and measure the length against a ruler.



CHOOSING THE SIZE OF YOUR BRACELET:

The usual bracelet sizing rules differ slightly in this case due to the design of the bracelet. Once you have found your size in the Bracelet Sizing Chart, Double Bone recommends adding one centimeter for a tight fit and two for a loose fit.

Please note that the Double Bone Wrist Sizer is an indicative guide only and therefore may not be an exact measure.
